Envelopes that list the different causes are enclosed with your tithing envelopes you received in themail. You can give a total amount which will be divided among these, or you may specify different amounts.

**Catholic Relief Services:** Provides funding for CRS, USCCB Office or International Justice and Peace, Migration and Refugee Services and Pastoral Care for Migrants and Refugees; relief work of the Holy Father; and the Catholic Legal Immigration Network.

**Catholic Home Missions Appeal:** The Appeal strengthens the Catholic Church in the US and its territories in the Caribbean and the Pacific where resources are thin and priests are few.

**Black and Indian Missions:** Collection for Black and Indian people continues as the embodiment of the Church's concern for evangelizing the Black & Indian peoples of the United States.

**The Catholic University of America:** Provides funding for academic scholarships at The Catholic University of America in Washington, DC.

**Catholic Communication Campaign (CCC):** Contributes to the process of evangelization by fostering activities in relation to television, radio, internet, the Catholic press, and other media.

**Retirement Fund For Religious:** Provides funding to any religious institute in the U.S. that is listed in the religious institute section of the OCD with an identifying OCD number.
