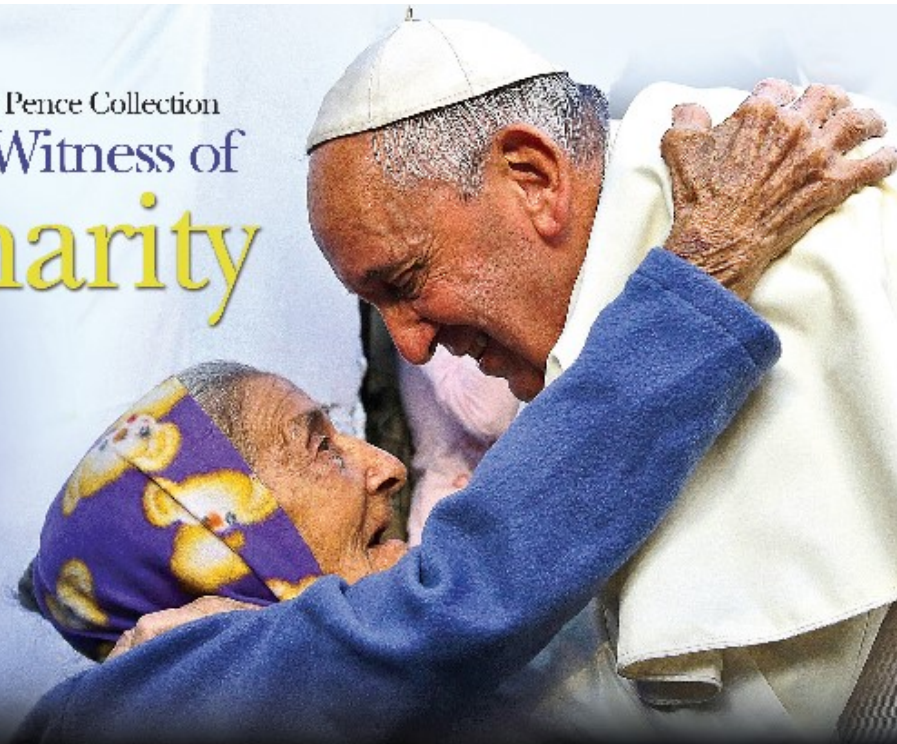


Peter's Pence Collection

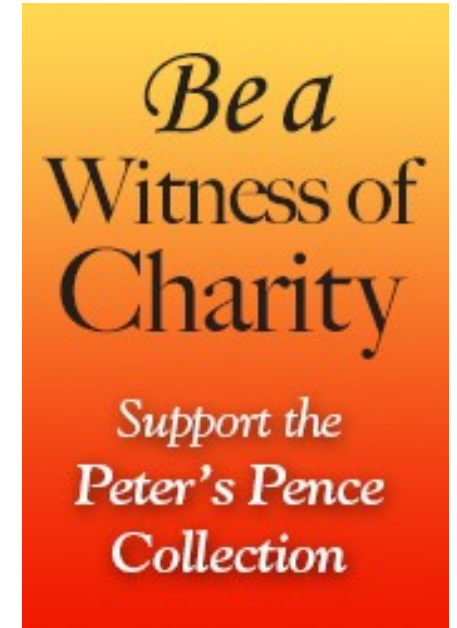
