### Mission Appeal

Please Welcome next week for the annual mission appeal, Fr. Ladislaus Bahali from the Diocese of Singida in Tanzania. This Diocese was established in 1972 south of Lake Victoria and has about 19,000 square miles, making it slightly smaller than the Diocese of Lincoln. Fr. Ladislaus is one of 67 priests who work in that diocese that has 24 parishes. This makes each parish about 25 miles by 25 miles square. To cover the extra work through the Diocese, they train and employ catechists, who work in the outstations that surround each parish. Some parishes have from 10 to 20 outstations which comprise a chapel and teaching center to help form people in the local area.

The main work the people do in his diocese is farming. They are small subsistence farms of 1 to 4 acres...hand planted, weeded and harvested. Annual rainfall is only about 20 inches, similar to what McCook, NE would receive.

This year Fr. Ladislaus is requesting help for the Diocese of Singida for four main areas. 1. Training of Catechists: Currently they have 464 and are always in need of more as well as furthering the training of those they have prepared. 2. Training of future priests: Currently they have 36 candidates for the priesthood in major seminary. 3. Empowerment of women in order that they may know their role in the development of the Church and to look for ways for them to generate income for their families. 4. Educational Laboratory Equipment: In their minor seminary they know they need to form the young men with a complete education, including science. They want to complete their labs with funding from this appeal.
